- 1. Browse the Web sites of any companies that interest you. Most companies will post job openings on their sites.
- 2. Go to a Web site specifically geared toward finding jobs. You can search for jobs on these sites by career field, location and even potential salary.
- 3. Search on your school's career-center Web site, if you're a student. These Web sites have job listings, guidance for writing résumés and advice on interviewing.
- 4. Visit an online newspaper and search the classifieds section for help-wanted ads and job opportunities. Many national as well as local newspapers have Web sites.
- 5. Check out search engines, as these also feature classified sections. Browse according to your location and interests.

- Some sites made specifically for finding jobs may require a membership fee. Read the fine print before signing up.
