

Delivery: Read articles 76-96 and do the analysis

The purpose of the stated work is to make an analysis of the school regulations of the A.Einstein High School.

The school regulation is a reglamentative text, that is a text that aims to regulate future behavior (own and / or others) and that can therefore: provide directions; give instructions; enunciate rules to be followed.

The recipient of this text is mainly students and teachers, but some articles (such as article 94) are also addressed to janitors and school staff, and was written by the school council and signed by the principal.

the goal is to make known to all school goers, students and not, what can and what can not be done in the school building and informs what are the sanctions that incumbent those who do not respect it.

The regulation is divided into chapters each chapter contains articles. The articles can be divided into five parts: first there are articles about bothering lessons, then about unjustified absences and false signatures, then about the use of non-authorized electronic devices and their use to violate privacy, then about school and it's property damage and lastly about the use of alcohol and drugs. Most of the punishments foreseen by these articles foresees the suspension and a research on the topic for which one has been suspended.

The articles are generally structured in one or two sentences, which begin by telling the forbidden behavior, continuing to consider using the conditional tense, and continuing with the punishment using the future tense. The language used is a formal language.
