In especially questions relating to the political and cultural independence of formerly subjugated people, and themes such as racialism and colonialism.

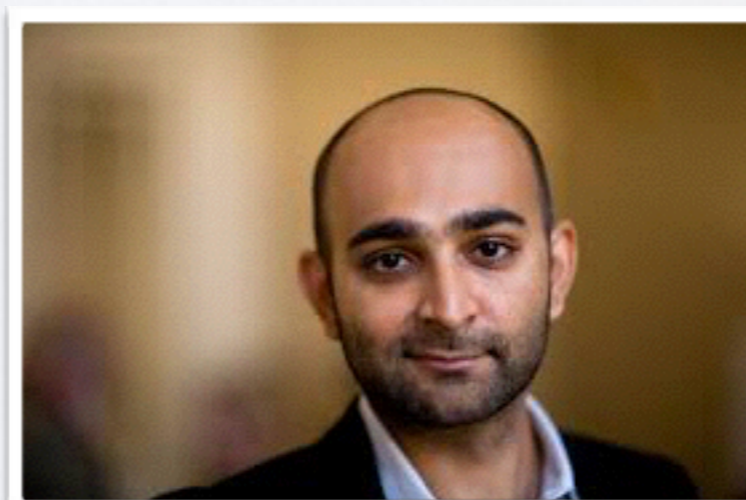
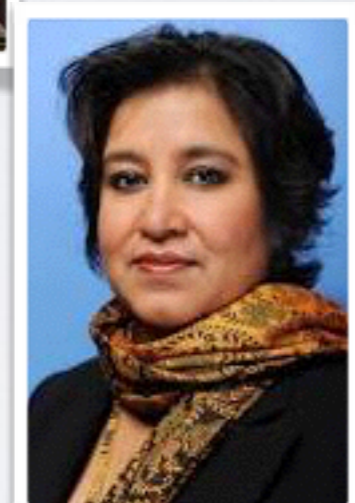
