How To Write an Argumentative Text

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What is an argumentative text?

PURPOSE: reader's persuasion of accepting the presented point

ARRANGEMENT: Three main components→ arranged into paragraphs

REQUIREMENTS: Cohesion and coherence and efficient argumentations

Make the reader curious and interested in the topic

Structure 1

- ► FIRST COMPONENT ⇒ INTRODUCTION
 - > outline the topic
 - expression of intention
 - Presentation of thesis
 - > provide background information and data

Use of suitable expressions for an opening paragraph

Structure 2

- ► SECOND COMPONENT ⇒ BODY
 - > explain the reasons why you should support the thesis
 - > Strong and effective argumentation
 - > Examples
 - Statistics
 - > Studies
 - Quotations
 - Presentation of cons and pros of main topic without being contradictory
 - Use of connectors and linkers

Structure 3

- ► THIRD COMPONENT ⇒ CONCLUSION
 - Restatement of the thesis
 - > Summerize of the argumentations
 - > Appealing to the reader personal emotions

Use of final expressions and connectors
