# DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING JR.

Period full of discriminations against African-Americans Situation improved in the 1960s ⇒ President L. Johnson signed the Civil Rights Act and the Voting Rights Act

discrimination based on race, national background and gender everyone was given the right to vote

Nevertheless many southern states continued to treat African-Americans as second class citizens.

## Rosa Parks refuses to give up her seat to a white man on a bus

- she is arrested
- **Montgomery African Americans** refuse to ride the buses.
- the Montgomery Improvement Association forms and elects 26 year-old King as its president.

«There comes a time when one must take a position that is neither safe, nor politic, nor popular, but he must take it because conscience tell him it is right.»

- M. L. King is elected president of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference.
- The Southern Christian Leadership **Conference** in the South help boycotting ⇒the Montgomery bus boycott is a success.
- M. L. King  $\Rightarrow$  president of the SCLC.

- M.L.King gives his "I Have a Dream" speech.
- March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom ⇒ to try and gain support for the Civil Rights Act.
- M.L. King gives his famous "I Have a Dream" speech on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial.



«I have a dream that my four little children will one day live in a nation where they will not be judged by the colour of their skin, but by the content of their character.»

M.L. King received a letter from a young girl, :

"I read that if you had sneezed, you would've died. I'm simply writing you to say that I'm so happy that you didn't sneeze".

throughout the past years.

According to Dr. M.L. King's sermon "The Drum Major Instinct

is related to service and love.

- greatness is attributed by one's own grace
- anyone can be great
- everybody can serve and love.

Black people have nothing to be ashamed of His yell with the crowd: "YES! I'M BLACK. I'M PROUD OF IT. I'M BLACK AND BEAUTIFUL!"
