Politics- Religion and Peace.

(His most important ideas in politics; religion and his relationship with religion his most influential friends for sharing his ideals; his ideas about World War II; his ideas about peace)

GROUP II: Beltramino, Vita, Bodigoi

Life

(What about his own family? What nationality was he? What school/s did he attend?- How was he considered inside his family? How did he relate to his closest friends? How was he considered inside his family? Difficult moments in his life What countries did he live during his life? What about his old age?- Where and when did he die?)

GROUP III: Vidal, Martinello, Candotti

Personality

(What about his childhood?- Was he a reserved or a sociable child? What languages did he know? Did he like travelling? How did he relate to his closest friends? Was his a happy life? What was his personality like? His personal life and his studies. His marriage)

GROUP IV: Vianello, Cecchetto, Parlati.

Prizes and reputation

(Reasons for Nobel Prize award; Why was he awarded the Nobel Prize? His speech on receiving the Nobel Prize; Other prizes and awards; What was A. Einstein's reputation among the common people?)

GROUP V: Del Stabile, Paolini, De Luca.

Passions, curiosities, studies

(What kind of student was he? What schools did he attend? What knowledge and curiosity led him to his discoveries? His interest in Physics - Why did he decide to study Physics? What kind of teacher was he? What did he like doing in his spare time?)

GROUP VI: Donaggio, Marega, Ferro.

(Historical background at the time of Einstein's studies and discoveries Reasons for studying Physics? What are his most relevant discoveries? Reason for taking part into the Manhattan Project. What teachings did he leave posterity? Was he real genius or did he himself made some mistakes?)
