

FRICO

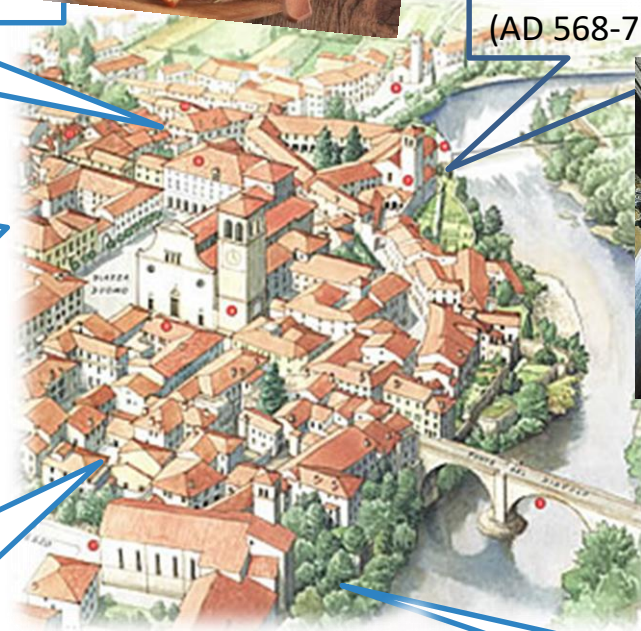

**THE TEMPLE**

The temple is one of the main attractions in Cividale, now a part of a set of buildings recognized by UNESCO world heritage list. It is a landmark of The Longobards in Italy (AD 568-774)

**NATIONAL MUSEUM OF ARCHEOLOGY**

Founded in 1817, the museum displays the «Altar of Rachtis» and many other Lombard artworks. Worth a visit!!!

**GUBANA**

The cake is made of raisins, pinenuts, grappa, and dried fruit. You can taste it at the historical pastry Cattarossi.

**DEVIL'S BRIDGE**

It was built in 1442. It is made of stone. The legend tells of a Devil, who built the bridge in exchange for the soul of the first creature that would walk on the same bridge.



TRAVELLING TO CIVIDALE

Cividale is a small town in the North-East of Italy, in Friuli-Venezia Giulia.

By CAR: close to the A23 (exit Udine North). Cividale is easily accessible from all parts of Friuli.

By RAIL: Cividale rail station is only 25 minutes drive from Udine. The railway station is a 10 minute walk to the town centre.
