

CIVIDALE DEL FRIULI

Cividale del Friuli is a small town located in Friuli-Venezia Giulia, a north-eastern region of Italy. It was founded by Julius Caesar between 50 and 56 B.C. under the name "Forum Julii".

It later became an important Lombard town. Cividale is located at the foot of the hilly territory of eastern Friuli and it is crossed by the Natisone River.

The city is about 17 kms far from Udine. In Cividale people speak "Friulano", an officially acknowledged language.

There is also a Slovenian-speaking minority.
