go-going

work-working

look-looking

When is it used?

Continuous Tenses

I am walking on the street.

Adjective

- He saw a sleeping dog in front of the house.

Gerund

She enjoys playing badminton.

Two actions at the same time

Tony left without saying anything.

To shorten relative clauses

The girl singing is my best friend.

After verbs such as; see, hear etc.

- He saw the dog sleeping in front of the house.

After verbs such as; waste, spend etc.

I don't want to waste time watching TV.
