<p>a. Predictions about future with verbs like think, believe, expect, etc.</p> <p>b. On-the-spot decisions</p> <p>c. Promises, threats, warnings, requests, hopes, offers</p> <p>d. Actions /events / situations which will definitely happens in the future</p>	<p>a. Action which will be in progress at a stated time in the future</p> <p>b. Action which will definitely happen in the future as the result of a routine or arrangement</p> <p>c. When we ask politely about someone's plans for the near future (why we want to know is if our wishes fit in with their plans)</p>	<p>a. Action that will be finished before a stated future time</p>	<p>a. Emphasis on duration of action in the future</p>
